

Instructions to Authors – Biophysical Letters

The Biophysical Letters section of the Journal is for the rapid publication of unusually important and unusually timely short articles in diverse areas of biophysics. Some of the descriptions that will be applied to Biophysical Letters are: studies of substantial importance for the biophysical community, articles likely to move the field forward in a major way, papers that present breakthrough initial observations, not archival, perhaps even controversial. Letters, which must be submitted in a formatted template, are sent to an Associate Editor of the Journal who will rapidly review it. Upon success at this stage, the Letter will be sent out for further review. It is expected that a decision will be reached within a month. Manuscripts requiring major revision will not be accepted; only the most minor of revisions will be permitted. Letters will be published online immediately upon acceptance and subsequently appear in the print version of BJ.

Biophysical Letters submissions must be submitted as follows:

- Download Word template by visiting http://submit.biophysj.org/journals/biophysj/forms/Letters_template.dot
- Cut and paste your Letters manuscript into the template, taking care to paste each section of your paper into the appropriate section on the template. Important: Your Biophysical Letters manuscript must be submitted as formatted by the template. Not doing so will delay the review of your paper as the article can not be reviewed unless submitted in the proper format.
- The entire manuscript must be no more than 3 formatted pages long, including figures.
- References must be numbered in the order of appearance; insert references numbers within parentheses, e.g. (1), within the text (NOTE: this is a different convention than used for regular BJ articles). Use the standard BJ format for the numbered citation list placed near the end of the text.
- Figures and captions should appear within the text, as soon after citation as possible.
- Your Letters submission may include supplemental material for publication online. However, this material is strictly restricted to experimental/computational details and other factual material. More discussion and conclusions are not permitted and will be grounds for rejection.
- Your Letters submission may include footnotes. These are to be combined with the reference list.
- Author must choose an Associate Editor/Area when submitting, or paper will be returned to author.
